

Glenn “Tiny” Fredericks Memorial Scholarship



Glenn “Tiny” Fredericks, was one of the founding fathers of ANCSA, The Kuskokwim Corporation, Georgetown Tribal Council and several non profit and for profit companies Tiny had a long standing devotion especially to The Kuskokwim Corporation ðTKCö, Georgetown Tribal Council and the middle Kuskokwim region.

Tiny was a leader in the formation of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA). He also played a major role in the merger of TKCø ten Village Corporationø to create a larger for-profit entity that has brought the Village Corporation to financial success. Tiny had been a leader with TKC

for over 20 years. With Glennø guidance the Native Village of Georgetown is well on its way to becoming a viable village.

Amount

The scholarship will range in an amount based on the donations received for it from individuals, businesses, and corporations. The amount for the first year is \$2,500. The amount for the following years will likely be \$3,000 or more.

Qualifications

1. Recipient must demonstrate motivation, academic, and leadership potential.
2. Recipient must be in good academic standing with a Cumulative G.P.A. above a 3.25.
3. Recipient must be attending a college or vocational institution the following fall.
4. Recipient must be going into a leadership/communications or business-related fields.
5. Recipient must be returning or contributing to the Kuskokwim Region after degree is received or training completed.
6. Native Preference applies to this private scholarship.

Application Procedures

1. Complete the special application form
2. Attach an essay per the instructions in the application.
3. List any organizations or clubs you were a member and explain your role.
4. Provide KEF with other materials requested in the application.

Mail completed applications to: Kuskokwim Educational Foundation, P.O. Box 227, Aniak, AK 99557 prior to May 15th.

The Glenn ðTinyö Fredericks Memorial Scholarship committee composed of members from The Kuskokwim Corporation, and Kuskokwim Educational Foundation will evaluate applications. The award will be announced at the Kuskokwim Corporation annual meeting scheduled for the first Saturday in June.

Letter of Application

You must include a letter or essay with your application that has the following information:

- Introductory paragraph about yourself
- Attach paragraph describing your talents, special interests and accomplishments.
- Paragraph describing your educational objectives, the reasons you selected these objectives and the progress you are making toward achieving these objectives.
- A photo of yourself used for publication.

High School Transcript

Arrange with the high school from which you graduated to mail directly to KEF a copy of your high school transcript.
 College transcript(s), trade school or other transcripts, training certificates, etc sent to KEF. Please arrange with the school registrar of each post secondary institution you have attended to have a copy of your transcript mailed directly to KEF. KEF will not accept copies of transcripts or grades provided by the student.

Two Letters of Recommendation

You may use letters provided for other applications or you may have letters specifically addressed to KEF.

Counselors, teachers, or employers should write personal letters of recommendation. Personal letters of recommendation will not be accepted from immediate relatives.

Please have the following information included in your letter: How long the letter writer has known you, how they perceive your interest in education, your outstanding talents and strengths, what goals and objectives the applicant has expressed.

Terms and Conditions

Students awarded scholarships agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Applicants are responsible for providing a complete application and arranging to have letters of recommendation and transcripts mailed directly to KEF. Copies of transcripts mailed to KEF directly by the student will not be accepted.
- 2) Scholarship awards are mailed directly to the school you are attending. Payments are generally made in two installments. Each installment is one-half of the total scholarship awarded. The first installment is usually mailed to the school prior to the start of the school year. The second installment is mailed to the school upon receipt from the school registrar the student's grades from the prior semester.
- 3) At the end of the first semester, the student is responsible for mailing a letter to KEF indicating their intention to enroll for the second semester.
- 4) Students are responsible for immediately notifying KEF of any changes in their status, change of address, or other information that affects their eligibility for scholarship awards.
- 5) At the end of each school year, the student is responsible for arranging with the school register to have a copy of their grades mailed to KEF.
- 6) All students must remain in good academic standing. College undergraduates must maintain at least a 3.25 grade point average (GPA where 4.0 = A) and complete a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester. Graduate students are expected to maintain a 3.25 GPA and also complete a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester.
- 7) Students who do not achieve the requirements of (6) will have one semester to improve their grades, otherwise, lose funding provided by Kuskokwim Educational Foundation.
- 8) Students pursuing a vocational program are expected to show satisfactory progress toward earning a vocational degree or certification.
